Minutes of Argoed Community Council meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018 at Markham Miners' Institute.

1784 To sign the register and receive apologies

1784.1 Community Councillors present: Chairman M. Williams, A. Davies, A. Jones and W. Williams

1784.2 Apologies were received from Cllrs. G. Lewis, H. Rowlands and J. Watkins 1784.3 Cllr. Keith Mills had emailed the Clerk tendering his resignation from the Community Council. He had explained that he was finding it extremely difficult to attend meetings due to work pressures.
