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Minutes of Argoed Community Council meeting held on 21st July 2014 at Argoed Village Hall.

1348 To sign the register and receive apologies

1348.1 Community Councillors present: Chairman K. Masson, G. Bineham, D. Briggs, A. Craddock, G. Lewis, H. Rowlands, J. Watkins and M. Williams. 1348.2 Apologies were received from A. Jones, L. Gardiner and W. Williams

1349 To receive a report from the Police

1349.1 Jeff Dugmore informed the meeting that forthcoming NATO conference in September in Newport would have an impact on Policing in the area.

He referred to the parking problems at the rear of Bryn Road Markham and also late-night use of the car park at the Leisure Centre.

A councillor raised the issue of inconsiderate parking at the riding school near The Travellers Rest in Manmoel.

Another councillor mentioned the bike trails at the caravan park. Jeff said that this was an organised event held throughout the Borough.

A councillor asked whether the Police would be increasing its presence in the village during the school holidays. Jeff said that the policing would be maintained at its normal level.
